A defeat was expected in the third game because they usually win the first two and lose the third; however, the Rangers came out on top with a score of 21-0. Injuries were plentiful that day to Brackman, Yearego, Jones, Whisman and Mullins.

All were able to play in the Lookout game the next week except Whisman. It turned out to be one of the hardest games of the year. Mullens threw a pass to Isaacs in the last fifty seconds to win by a score of 14-12. Next week Rainelle captured the fifth straight game, winning from White Sulphur Springs to the tune of 26-0. Everybody was in in tip-top shape, for it had to make up for the defeat they handed us the year before.

The next week was a sad one; Ronceverte broke the the season's winning streak by defeating us 6-0. The following week at Montgomery, our boys were outclassed in power; however, they showed that they couldn't be pushed around by forcing over one touchdown and passing for another. The "Greyhounds" won 20-7. Later came Alderson, expecting to defeat us, which they almost did. The score 6-6 didn't reveal much about the game. From the line of scrimmage Rainelle had 18 first downs to their opponents 0. Rainelle played one of their best games of the season with Oak Hill, but just couldn't get it over pay dirt.

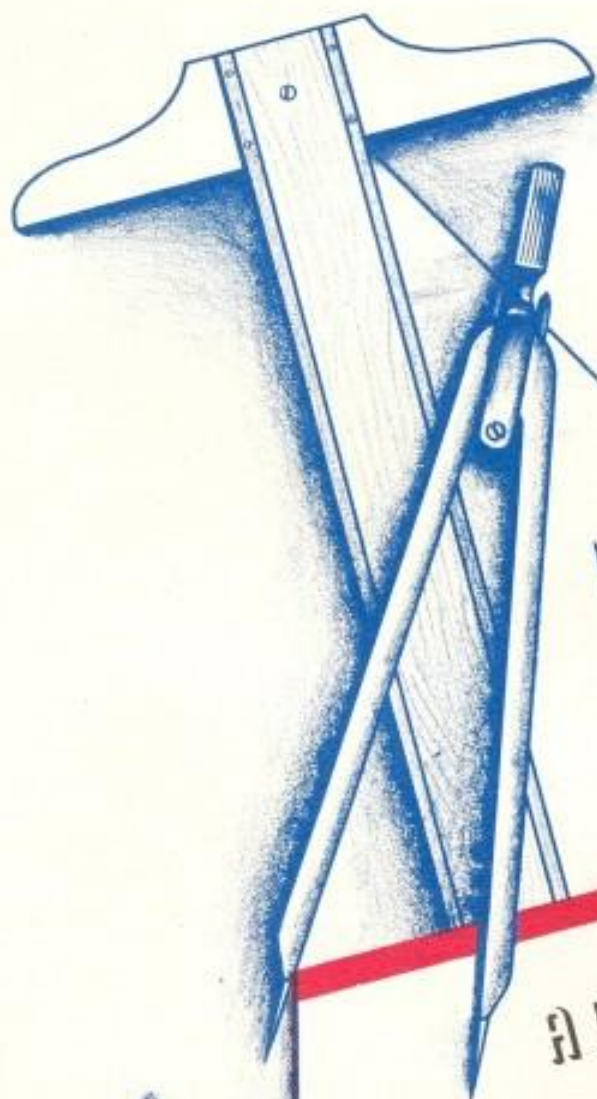
