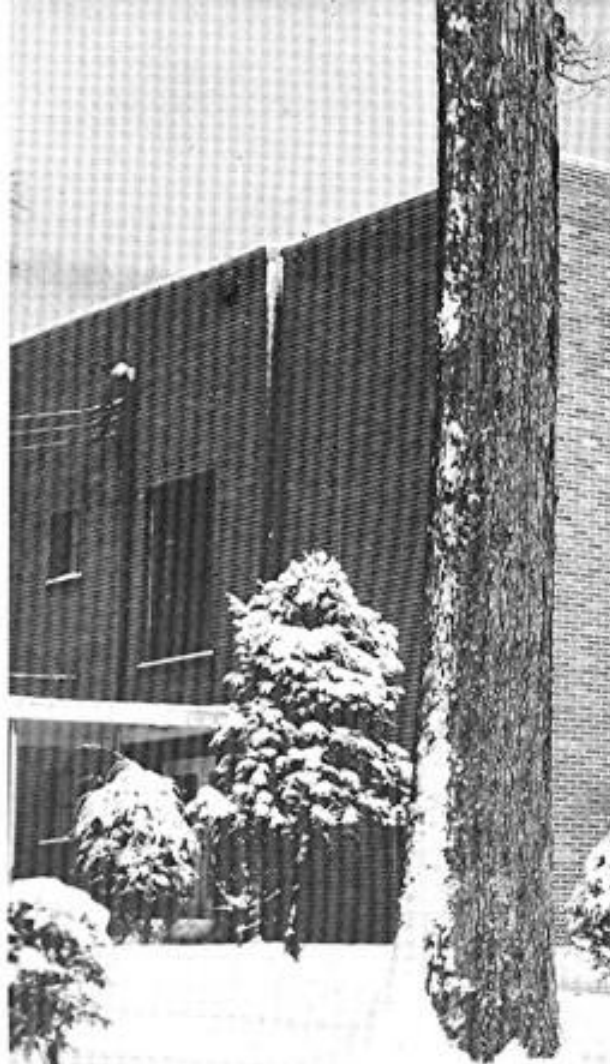

We would like to thank all the merchants for their co-operation in making this annual possible. The association we have had with them has been a real pleasure.

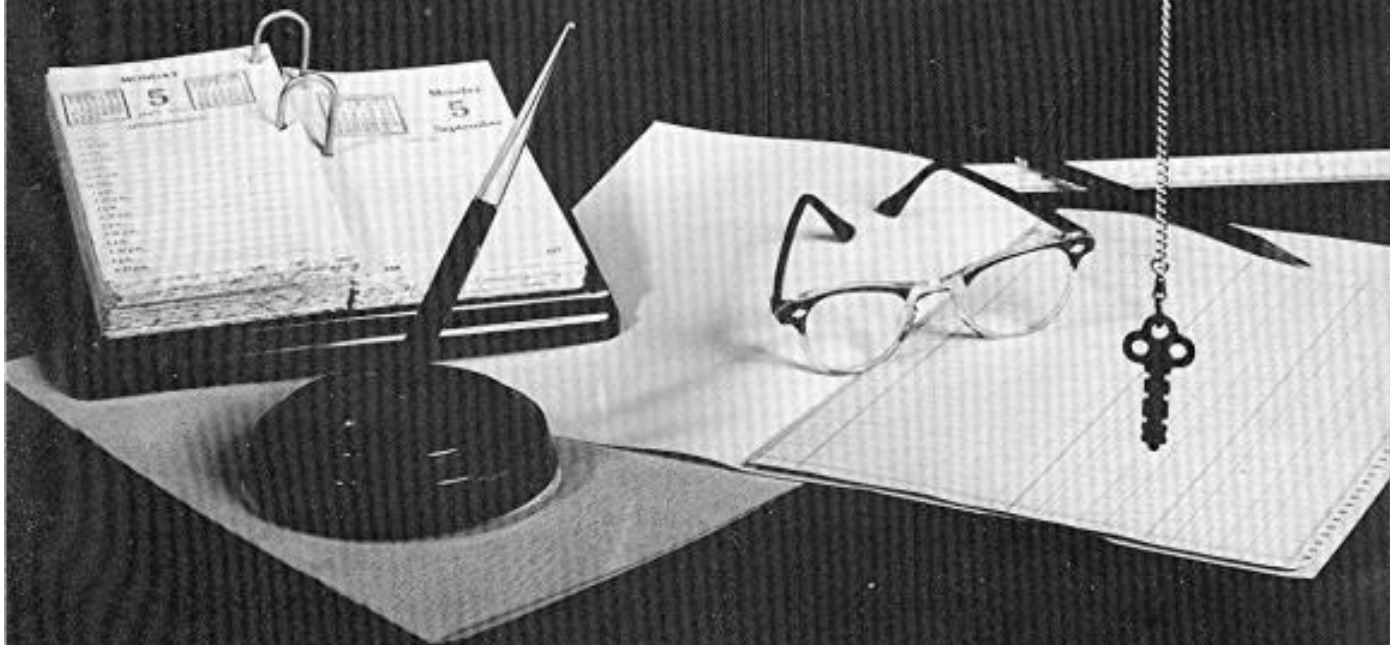

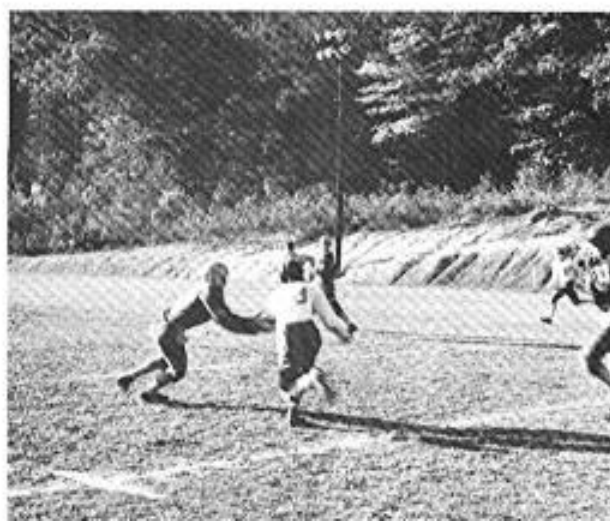

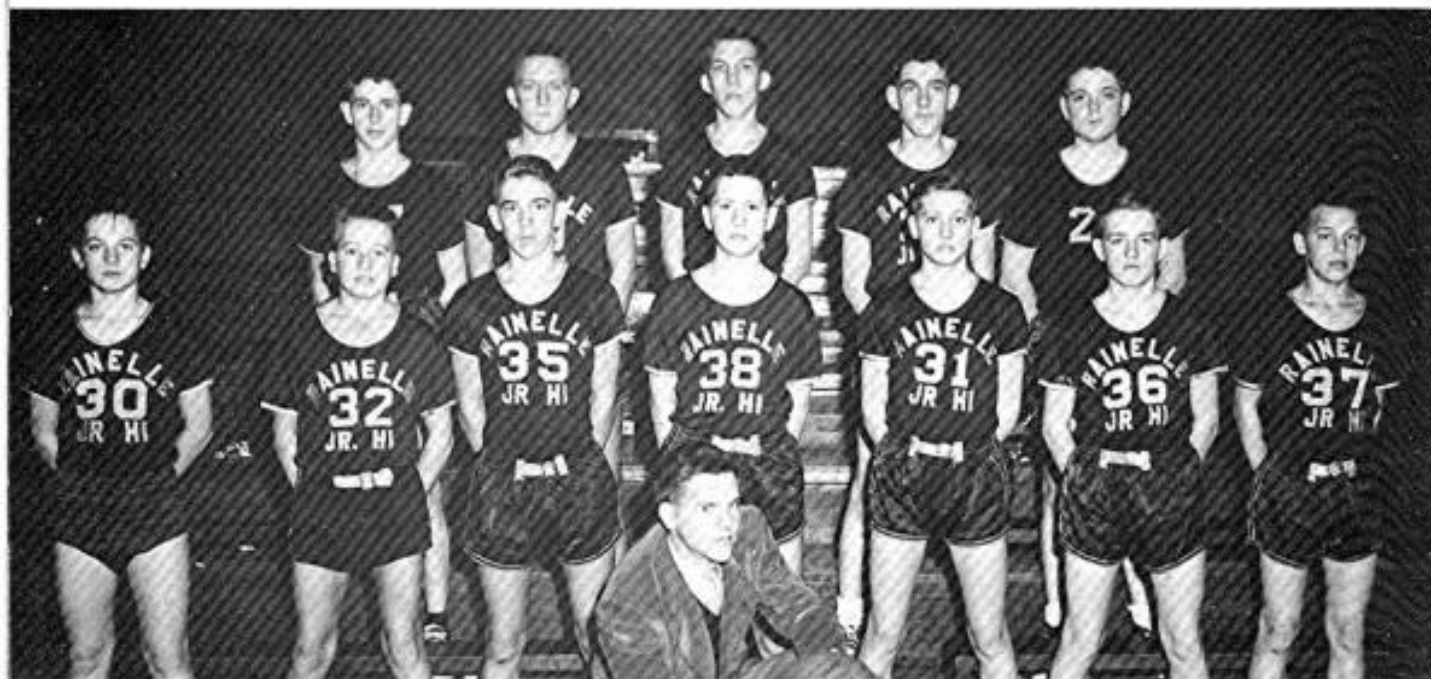
