We came to Greenbrier West seeking many things. The hours flew as new days and new ways passed by.



Remember the first day and how it all seemed a little unreal, so new, so different? Then think about how it is now, so alive, so natural.



Linda Meadows was a member of the United States delegation to the First Inter-American Youth Conference in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.





The Greenbrier West Cavaliers made history by opening their first football season with a 6-0 victory over the Richwood Lumberjacks.




Cedar Grove

The Cavaliers suffered their fourth loss in a row to the Class AA State Champions of Hinton by a score of 27-0.


Fayetleville
