This year school spirit and pride have grown. But if this school is ever to become great, they must grow even more.

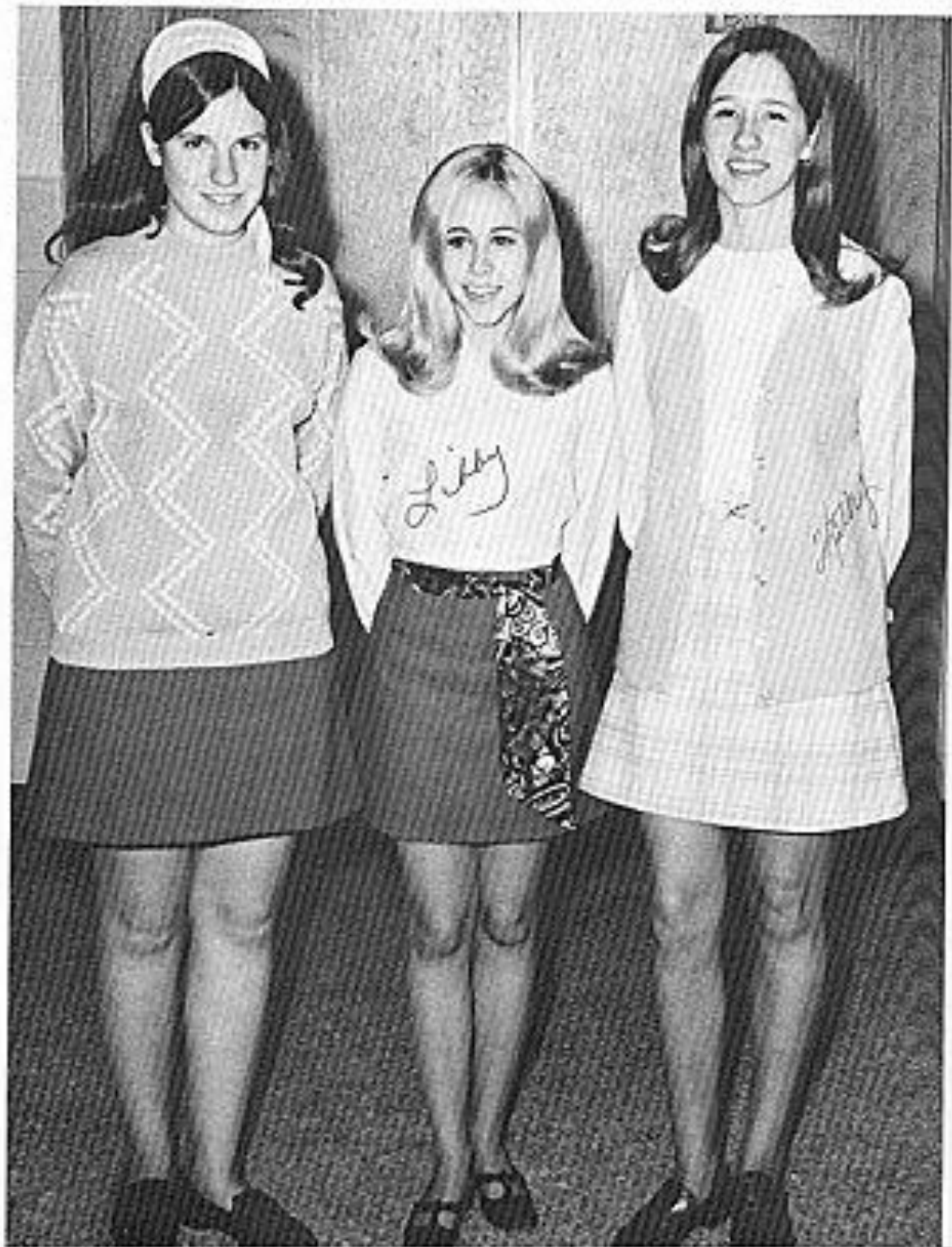

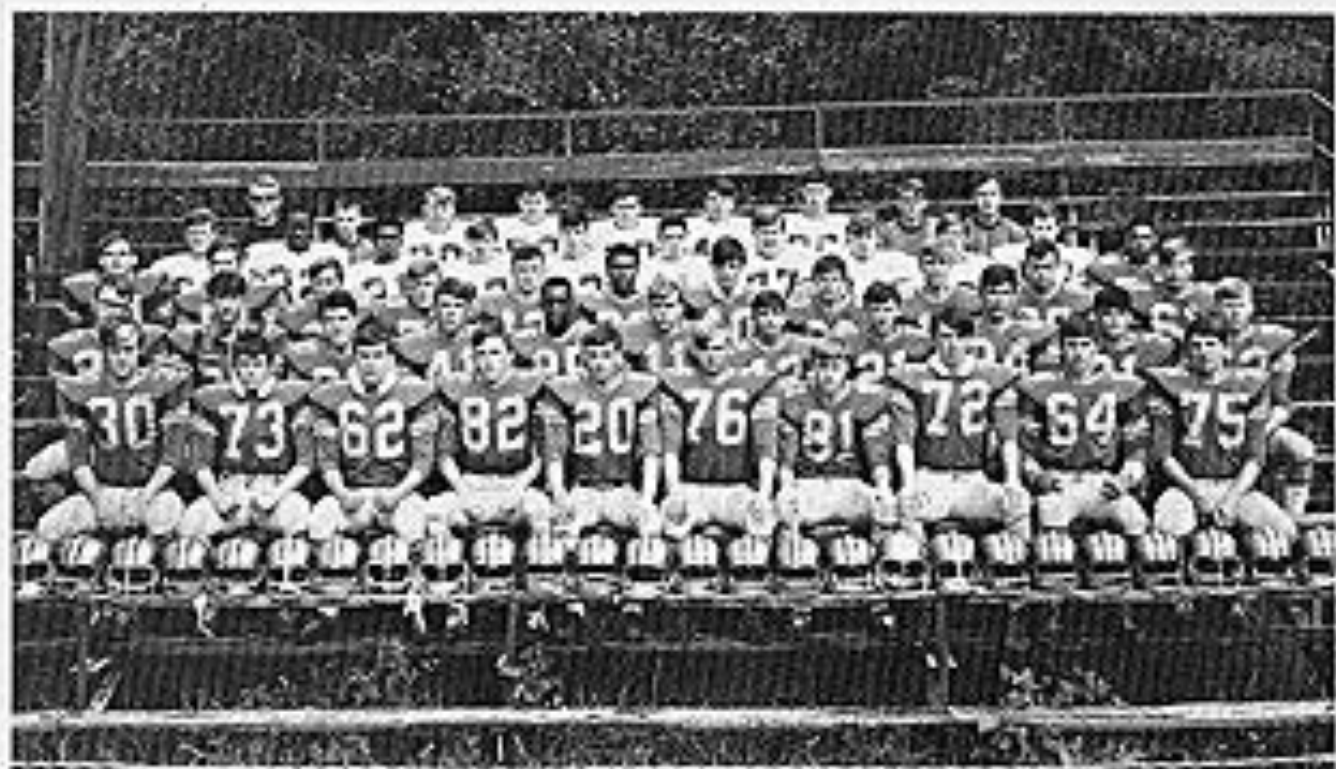


### The Worst Defeat

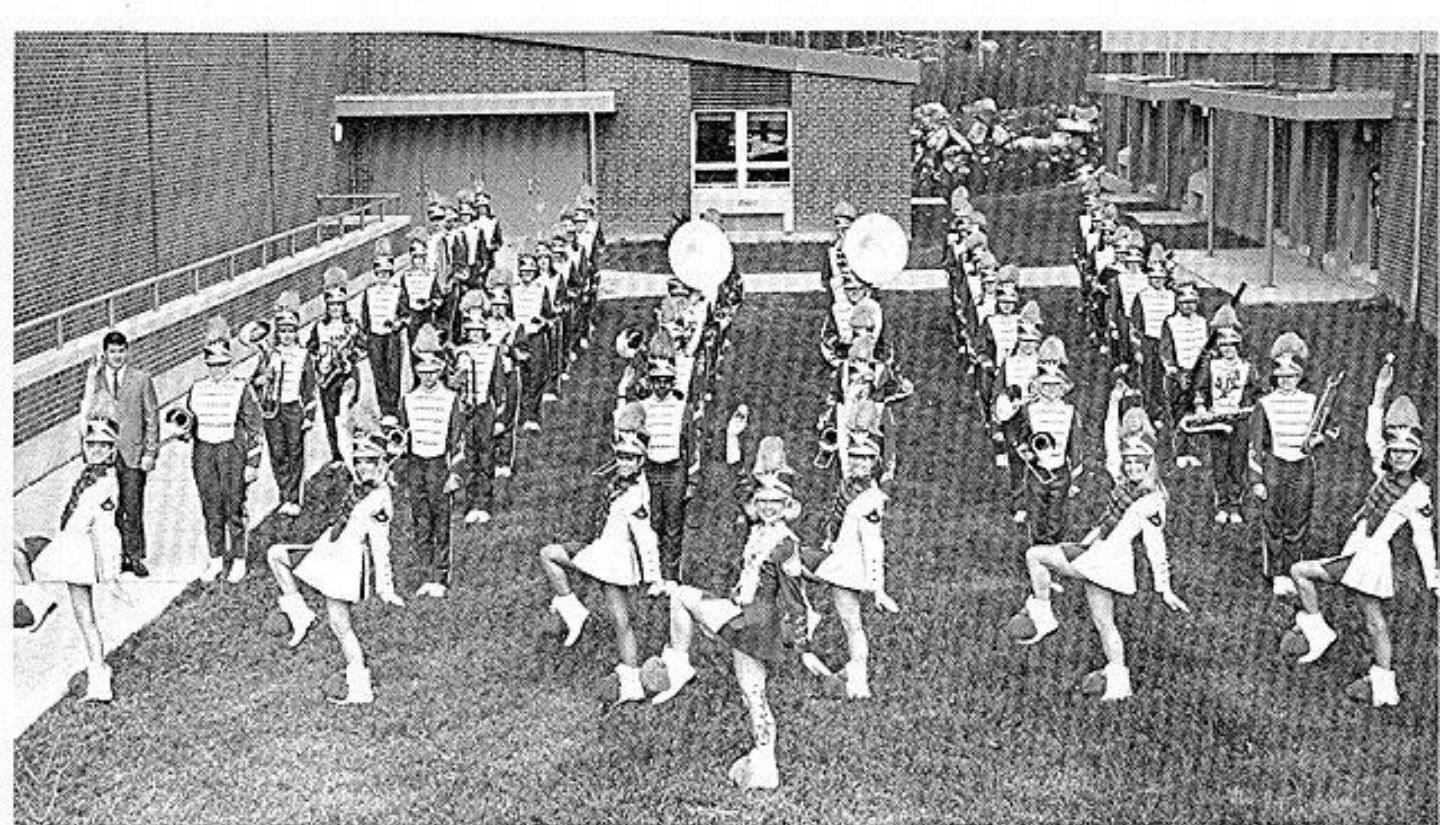




## ***The Cavalier Band***
